Dear Parents or Guardians:

School nurses may give non-prescription medications with parental permission. The following guidelines need to be followed:

1. The school nurse must assess the child's complaint and symptoms to determine if other measures can be used before medication is given.
2. The school nurse must be notified of any *allergies* to medications that your child has.
3. **BY LAW, ALL MEDICATIONS SENT TO THE SCHOOL MUST BE IN THEIR ORIGINAL CONTAINER (LABELED WITH DOSAGE AND DIRECTION FOR USE). MEDICATIONS SENT IN PLASTIC BAGS, ETC., WILL NOT BE ADMINISTERED. PARENTS OR GUARDIANS MUST BRING ALL MEDICATIONS TO SCHOOL.**
4. Due to limited storage space, the following list (see below) of over the counter medications will be stocked by the school, therefore it will no longer be necessary to provide them for your children.
5. The school nurse will keep a record of medication given.
6. Nurses must use restraint at all times in the use of non-prescription medicines.
