1 – TI 83 or TI 84 graphing calculator (regular or plus version) for all math courses

1 – Thumb drive (labeled with your name) for electronic storage

1 – Single subject notebook where pages can be removed neatly,

1 – Two-pocket folder, pens/pencil. Students may participate in PE wearing their regular dress code attire as long they change into sneakers. If students choose to change, **they may only wear solid color athletic shorts (mid- thigh or to the knee) or athletic pants and an MOT Charter spirit-wear t-shirt.**

1 – Small backpack to carry the above items. (No large or heavy backpacks in the building, with our 1:1 laptop program, students will not need a large bag and there is limited space within the classrooms).

Uniform Reminder: Students are expected to be in dress code beginning the first day of school. Order your uniform shirts, fleeces from one of our approved vendors (list provided on next/reverse page) as soon as possible.

Any additional supplies will be course specific, if applicable the additional supply list will be provided by course instructor once classes begin.

1 – Laptop case (one-time* cost) – fee information available in August

This case **MUST BE** purchased at school to meet insurance requirements) for carrying the laptop during the school day

* Note: A lost case will incur a fee to replace

1 – Insurance for school-issued Chromebook laptop – fee information available in August
This is a required yearly insurance fee for all students; please note the insurance fee is non-refundable, not pro-rated and non-transferable.
